

Gospel conversation starters

1. Idea to reach children: Get local school district calendar and host camps when school is out. There is a tangible need for childcare and an opportunity to share gospel.

3. You can say, "Today we are going to discuss and address your needs as a whole person—emotionally, mentally, spiritually, and physically, is that okay? (That allows us to circle back to a spiritual and hopefully evangelistic conversation.)"
4. I usually talk about my struggles and where my hope comes from. I also talk about how Jesus changed my life and how I want to share that with others.
